

Leyden Rifle Club MEMBERSHIP POLICY

- **Individual:** Persons 21 years or older are required to purchase an LRC membership at the current dues; it is an individual membership which is renewed annually. An LRC membership card will be issued for the current year. Members are allowed to use the ranges daily from 8:00 AM to dusk; there are no daily range fees. Range fees are required for the LRC's scheduled high power rifle matches. Persons, who are 21 years or older, belongs to a current LRC member's immediate family, and is not a current LRC member is prohibited from any shooting activity at the Club.
- **Family:** The LRC does not offer family memberships. Persons of an LRC member's family who are 21 years of age or older must join the Club as an individual member (as stated above).
- **Junior:** Persons who under 21 years of age and who belong to a current LRC member's immediate family are eligible to become a member of the LRC's 'Junior Division'. Membership to the LRC's 'Junior Division' is free and a 'JD' membership card will be issued. 'Junior Division' members shall be admitted to the Club's premises only if accompanied with and shall be under the responsibility of the parent who is a current member of the Club. 'Junior Division' member(s) must be under direct supervision of his/her parent at all times while on the Club's premises.

LIABILITY WARNING

The LRC member, accompanied with Junior Division members, will assume all liability for and are fully responsible for the safety of the Junior members. In so doing, the LRC member holds harmless the Leyden Rifle Club, its Officers, Directors and/or Range Officers, for any personal injury and/or loss of life to the Junior members while on the Club's property. The LRC member does hereby release, waive, forever discharge, hold harmless and covenant not to sue from any, and all, liability, claims, demands, and actions of whatever kind on nature either in law or equity, which may arise or arise hereafter from the Junior members' participation with firearms.

- **Honorary:** A person must: 1) be 70 years of age or older and 2) have been an LRC member for 10 consecutive years.
- **Non-Member:** Any person, who is not a current LRC member and is found on Club property, shall be deemed as TRESPASSING and will be requested to leave the LRC premises immediately. Repeat violators will be prosecuted by the LRC for trespassing.

Reminder:

Always carry your current membership card with you while on the Club's premises.

Note: Pet owners are responsible for their pets, either on a leash or in a vehicle at all times, while on the Club's premises.
