Registration time for all AM match shoots are at 8:00 – 8:30 AM with the first line ready to shoot by 9:00 AM. Club membership and dues are \$35.00. Range fees for every match will be \$3.00. Club ammunition for both .30-'06 and .223 cartridges will be available to use at the LRC rifle matches (includes sighters) at a donation of \$20.00 for either the 40 or the 50 round rifle matches. At the October 2012 annual meeting, it was voted to limit both .30-'06 and .223 ammunition availability for only the rifle matches. All club ammunition spent cartridge brass is property of the LRC. Both M1 & Springfield rifles are available for members to use free at the Sunday LRC rifle matches.

Club policy for all rifle matches: After shooting sighters using 3" diameter spotters, only golf tees will be used for 'spotting' the target's bullet holes during all 4 stages of fire during a rifle the match.
