

# Service Rifle Range Commands

Each stage-of-fire has a 3-minute preparation time; shooters may handle their rifles and dry fire.

Standing. The Range Officer will give the commands:

*Shooters: This is your 1<sup>st</sup> stage of fire. You will have 10 minutes to fire 10 rounds in the standing or offhand position.*

*Shooters: You may load.*

*Is the line ready? The line is ready.*

*Ready on the right. Ready on the left.*

*All ready on the firing line, you may commence fire!*

Sitting Rapid Fire. The Range Officer will give the commands:

*Shooters: This is your 2<sup>nd</sup> stage of fire. You will have 60 seconds to fire 10 rounds from the standing to sitting or standing to kneeling position.*

*Shooters: You may load.*

*Is the line ready? The line is ready.*

*Ready on the right. Ready on the left.*

*All ready on the firing line, you may commence fire!*

Prone Rapid Fire. The Range Officer will give the commands:

*Shooters: This is your 3<sup>rd</sup> stage of fire. You will have 70 seconds to fire 10 rounds from the standing to prone position.*

*Shooters: You may load.*

*Is the line ready? The line is ready.*

*Ready on the right. Ready on the left.*

*All ready on the firing line, you may commence fire!*

Prone Slow Fire. The Range Officer will give the commands:

*Shooters: This is your 4<sup>th</sup> stage of fire. You will have 20 minutes to fire 20 rounds from the standing to prone position.*

*Shooters: You may load.*

*Is the line ready? The line is ready.*

*Ready on the right. Ready on the left.*

*All ready on the firing line, you may commence fire!*
