Service Rifle Range Commands

Each stage-of-fire has a 3-minute preparation time; shooters may handle their rifles and dry fire.

Standing. The Range Officer will give the commands:

Shooters: This is your 1st stage of fire. You will have 10 minutes to fire 10 rounds in the standing or offhand position.

Shooters: You may load.

Is the line ready? The line is ready.

Ready on the right. Ready on the left.

All ready on the firing line, you may commence fire!

<u>Sitting Rapid Fire</u>. The Range Officer will give the commands:

Shooters: This is your 2^{nd} stage of fire. You will have 60 seconds to fire 10 rounds from the standing to sitting or standing to kneeling position.

Shooters: You may load.

Is the line ready? The line is ready.

Ready on the right. Ready on the left.

All ready on the firing line, you may commence fire!

Prone Rapid Fire. The Range Officer will give the commands:

Shooters: This is your 3^{rd} stage of fire. You will have 70 seconds to fire 10 rounds from the standing to prone position.

Shooters: You may load.

Is the line ready? The line is ready.

Ready on the right. Ready on the left.

All ready on the firing line, you may commence fire!

Prone Slow Fire. The Range Officer will give the commands:

Shooters: This is your 4th stage of fire. You will have 20 minutes to fire 20 rounds from the standing to prone position.

Shooters: You may load.

Is the line ready? The line is ready.

Ready on the right. Ready on the left.

All ready on the firing line, you may commence fire!
